ATTN: Students planning on entering college in 2019:

The North Wilkes Steering Committee is offering a scholarship of \$500 to two high school seniors from the Tignall/North Wilkes area that plan to enter college or a technical school in the fall quarter of 2019 and will be a freshman in college or technical school when this scholarship is awarded. This scholarship will be awarded at the 'I'd Rather Be in Tignall' Fall festival on Nov. 9, 2019.

Applications for this scholarship should be submitted in the following manner: 1. Students should submit a letter of application in narrative form including: personal background (name, age, date and place of birth, school(s) attended, etc.; educational goals and reasons for the selection of these goals; major interests and activities (school, extracurricular, and community; and honors and accomplishments. 2. Letter should be accompanied by an official record of academic achievements, including SAT scores and cumulative GPA. 3. Letters of reference from two professional educators and one letter from a member of the community (pastor, employer or friend) should be included. The application letter should include the following information in the top right hand corner: name, address, phone number, and email. All this material should be placed in a large manila envelope and mailed.
