On Track for Graduation

- Check your transcript to make sure you are on track for graduation and that you have what you need to be eligible for your future plans

Tests

- Register for the SAT at www.collegeboard.org (4-year or 2-year schools)
- Register for the ACT at www.act.org (4-year or 2-year schools)
- Test dates are posted outside my office and are also available online
- ACCUPLACER for Technical Colleges (can be administered at the school you plan to attend...contact the school for more information)
- If you are interested in the military, see Mrs. Callaway for information on the ASVAB and recruiter information.

Applying to College/Technical Schools

- Most early decisions and early action applications are due the first of October. Check individual schools for exact dates.
- Request transcripts through GAFutures for schools in Georgia. Out of state school transcript requests are completed by Ms. Favors.
- If you are having trouble requesting transcripts through Georgia Futures, see Mrs. Callaway or email her.
- For letters of recommendation from teachers, give teacher(s) your resume and make the request at least two weeks prior to the date you need the letter.
- If you are applying through the Common Application, you need to keep Mrs. Callaway informed if you need a mid-year report or any other information. This is your responsibility to keep Mrs. Callaway up to date with your college application needs.

- Every Senior will complete an application for college/technical school or military commitment or if already accepted show proof of acceptance by copy of email or acceptance letter
- GA Futures will be used to apply for in state schools
- Wear college gear from any school on this day
